TEXAS HISTORY DAY – CONTEST DAY GUIDELINES

FOR ALL CATEGORIES

- Students should arrive at their designated room approximately 30 minutes prior to their interview or presentation.
- **Please be prepared for schedule changes.** If there are last minute cancellations, students may be asked to interview or present their entry at an earlier time.
- Students will not be interviewed in the Final Round of judging. Only Performance and Documentary students will be called back for the Final Round.

EXHIBIT AND POSTER CATEGORIES

- Upon entering the exhibit hall (Austin Room), if you have difficulty finding your assigned space, ask one of the exhibit hall monitors for assistance.
- When setting up your exhibit or poster, make sure to leave **three copies of your written materials** (Title page, Process Paper and Annotated Bibliography) in front of your exhibit or poster. If you have made any changes since the materials were uploaded, **highlight those changes** for the judges in the copies on the table.
- **During judging, students must wait in the 2nd floor lobby** near the Bob Bullock statue. You will be called into the exhibit hall at your judging time. **FOOD IS NOT ALLOWED IN THE BULLOCK MUSEUM.**
- Although the museum will be locked on Friday night, extra security will not be provided. Students should not leave any valuable or irreplaceable items on their exhibits overnight. The Texas State Historical Association and the Bullock Texas State History Museum cannot be held responsible for any theft, loss, or damage to exhibits.
- The exhibit hall will be closed to everyone except judges, staff, and students during judging.
- Students do not stand by their exhibits/posters or appear before judges during the Final Round of judging.
- Exhibits and Posters may be taken down following the Public Viewing on Saturday. **All exhibits and posters must be removed from the exhibit hall by 4:30 PM.** You must remove your exhibit and poster before the Awards Ceremony.

DOCUMENTARY CATEGORY **New this year: Documentary Finals – Please retain your flash drive!**

- Documentary students should bring **three copies of their written materials** (Title page, Process Paper, and Annotated Bibliography) for the judges. Any changes made after the file was uploaded during the registration process need to be **highlighted for the judges.**
- If students have made changes to the documentary since uploading it during registration, students need to **bring their documentary on a flash drive/ thumb drive.** We recommend testing the file from the flash drive on different computers.
- This year documentary students will be called back to present for Final Round judges. The call for finals will be posted on texashistorday.com at approximately 1:00 PM. The finals list will also be posted outside the final's rooms in CBA and SZB.

PERFORMANCE CATEGORY

- Storage rooms for props are available in both Jester Center and Welch Hall (JES A209A) (WEL 1.316)
- Students should present **three copies of their written materials** (Title Page, Process Paper, and Annotated Bibliography) to the judges upon entering the judging room.
- Performances may be video recorded or photographed ONLY with the permission of the students performing. A Texas History Day staff videographer/photographer may be photographing entries.
- Students, teachers, and other audience members may enter or leave the room only between performances.
- The call for finals will be posted on texashistorday.com at approximately 1:00 PM. The finals list will also be posted outside the final's rooms in JES and WEL.

PAPER AND WEBSITE CATEGORIES

- **Paper students** should bring one copy of their written materials (Title Page, Process Paper, Paper and Annotated Bibliography) as a reference during the interview process.
- **Website students** should bring one copy of their written materials (Process Paper and Annotated Bibliography) as a reference during the interview process.



PARKING OPTIONS FOR TEXAS HISTORY DAY

CARS AND VANS (less than 6 feet 8 inches in height)

Friday, April 19, 2024

- **BULLOCK PARKING GARAGE – Free parking from 2:00 – 5:00 PM**
The Bullock Texas State History Museum's Parking Garage is available for FREE PARKING from 2:00 – 5:00 PM only for Check-in and Exhibit Set-Up. Inform the parking attendant that you are there for Texas History Day.
- **UT PARKING GARAGES – Paid Parking**
Garages on the University of Texas campus are available on an hourly paid basis. The closest garage to the Bullock Museum is the Brazos Garage located at the corner of MLK and Brazos Streets. See the map for other garage locations.

Saturday, April 20, 2024

- **GARAGE E – Free Parking on Saturday**
This Texas State Parking Garage has been reserved for Saturday, April 20, 2024. Parking in this lot is free on Saturday. It is not available on Friday.
- **BULLOCK PARKING GARAGE – Paid Parking on Saturday**
The Bullock Texas State History Museum's Parking Garage is available for Texas History Day. **Parking is \$15 per vehicle on Saturday, no re-entry.**
- **UT PARKING GARAGES – Paid Parking**
Garages on the University of Texas campus are available on an hourly paid basis. The closest garage to the Bullock Museum is the Brazos Garage located at the corner of MLK and Brazos Streets. See the map for other garage locations.

BUSES AND LARGE VEHICLES (over 7 feet tall)

*****PLEASE NOTE: There is not any parking available near the contest site for parking buses and other large vehicles. For that reason, the bus driver CANNOT be a teacher or chaperone responsible for participating students.*****

BUS UNLOADING There are two unloading zones (see the map provided by the Bullock Museum for routes)

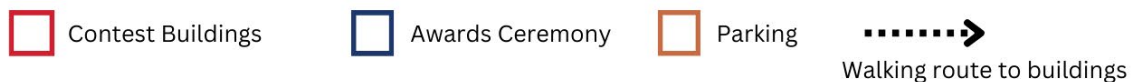
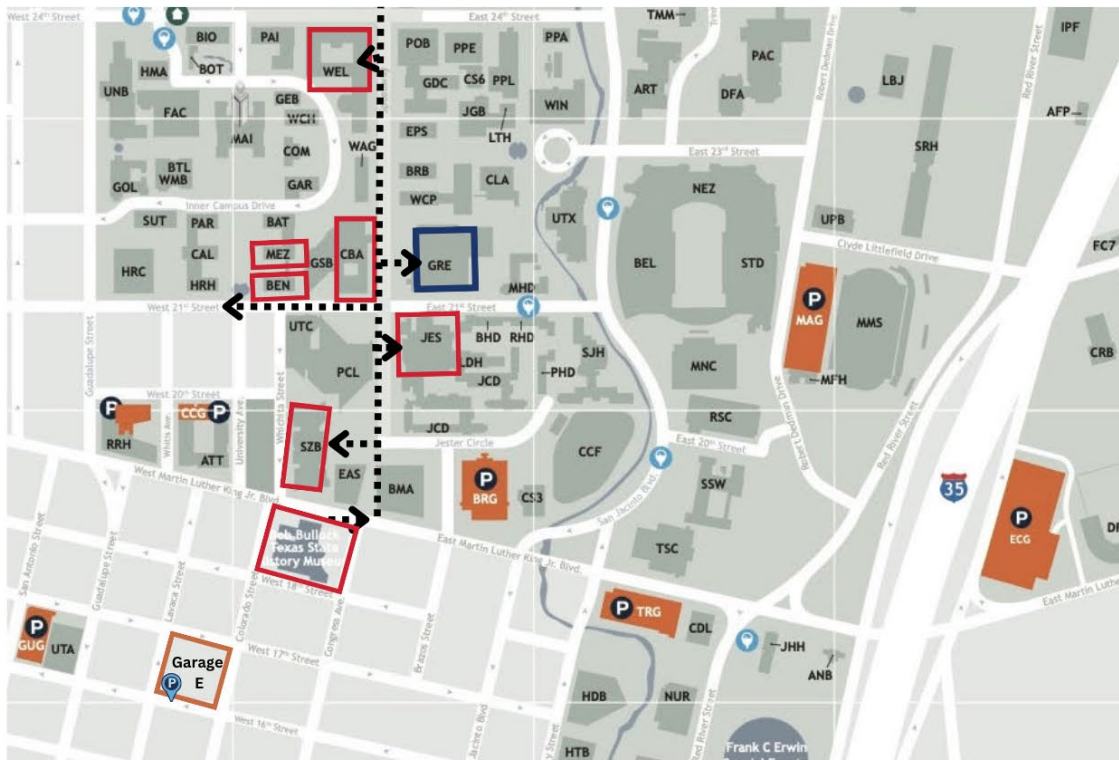
- **Colorado Street Bus Zone** – Behind the Bullock Museum on Colorado Street at 17th St.
- **18th Street Bus Zone** – Located on 18th and Brazos Streets

Once the students and their projects are unloaded, the bus must leave the loading zone.

Some off-site parking options for buses include:

- returning to the hotel (if group is staying overnight),
- the Capitol Complex parking on Trinity Street between 13th and 14th Streets (this space is limited)
- Hancock Center located on Red River at 41st Street.



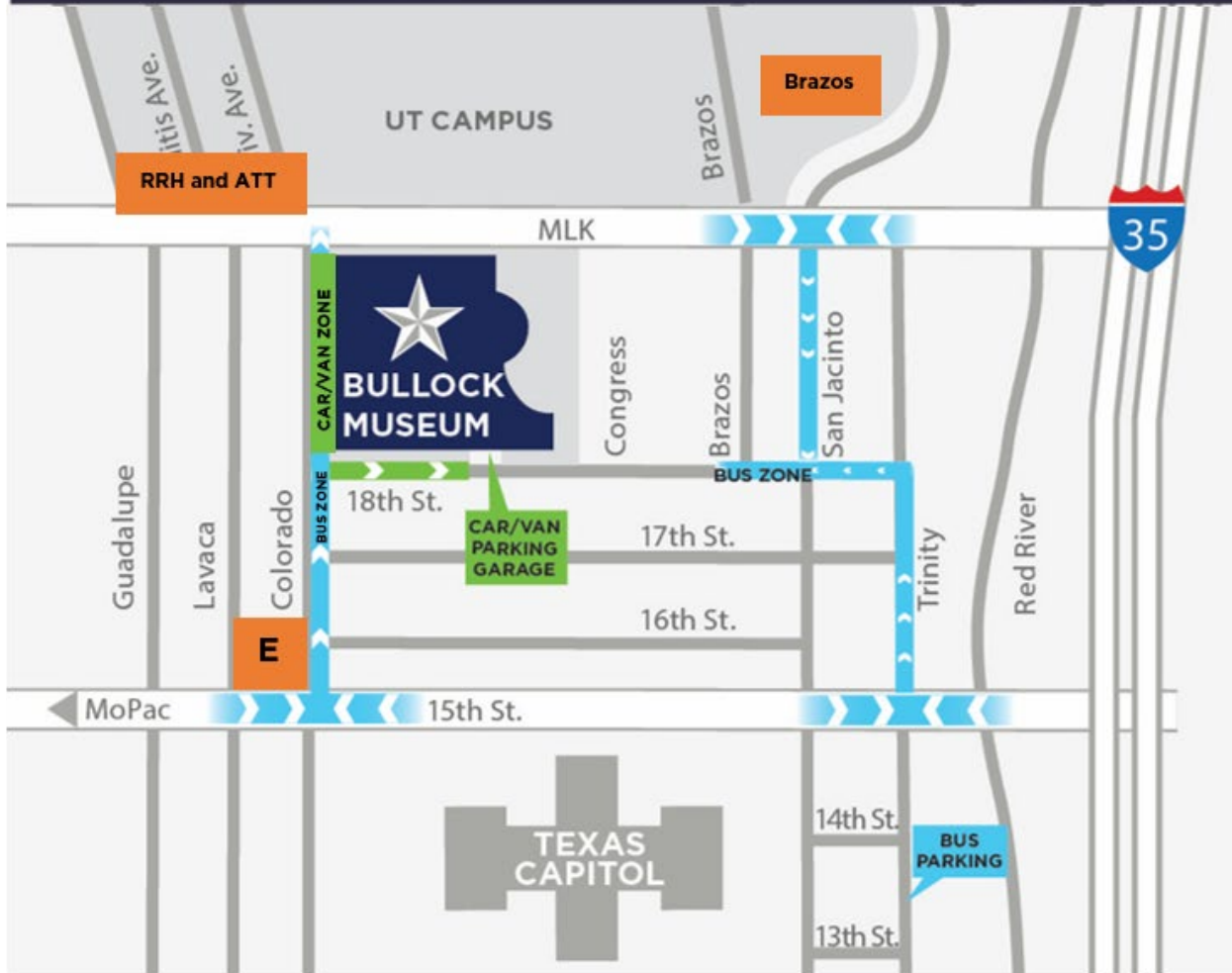


Bullock Museum Exhibitions

BUS ROUTE AND LOADING ZONE

New: There are two Bus Loading Zones.

Colorado Bus Zone is behind the Museum on 17th and Colorado Street, 18th Bus Zone is in front of the Museum at 18th and Brazos.

Buses and large vehicles (over 7 feet tall) must load/unload quickly at either Bus Loading Zone. For Colorado Bus Zone, buses must approach Colorado from the south via 15th Street and unload on the east side of Colorado, the side closest to the Museum. For 18th Bus Zone, buses must approach 18th Street heading west and unload on the north side of 18th.

Once the exhibits and passengers are loaded/unloaded, the bus must leave the Loading Zone. There is limited bus parking at the Capitol bus zone on Trinity between 13th and 14th Street. If there are no spots available, the bus will need to leave the Capitol Complex.

CAR/VAN ROUTE AND PARKING

The entrance to the Bullock Museum's parking garage is located on 18th St. and Colorado, on the south side of the Museum.

If unloading an exhibit from a vehicle (less than 7 feet tall), it can park in the Bullock Museum parking garage on Friday. You may also load/unload behind the Museum on Colorado Street.

PARKING FEE

-On Friday 4/19: free parking for check-in and exhibit unloading
-On Saturday 4/20: the fee is \$15; plan to park for the day. Re-entry and overnight parking are not permitted.
